Greetings!

This is to bring to your attention that Redbricks is hosting the Reading Challenge organised by the British Council this year, on the theme 'Animal Agents'.

The Reading Challenge is a massive reading promotion programme for children and young people in the UK. It is conceptualised by The Reading Agency in collaboration with the Arts Council England, British Council and the BBC and now runs in libraries and schools all over the world. In the Reading Challenge children are challenged to read a range of books and are encouraged to complete the challenge with an exciting range of incentives and activities. The programme is now being rolled out in over 30 countries like Spain, Thailand, Malaysia, Portugal, Kazakhstan, Singapore, Oman, Romania, France, Greece, Vietnam, Columbia, Venezuela, SriLanka and India.

The challenge includes a six week campaign, during which the participants need to read at least 6 of the titles which are part of the collection curated and shared by the Council. Participants also need to participate in the workshops conducted at British Council, Vastrapur relating to this Challenge.

The modus operandi for the Reading Challenge is as follows:

- Children aged 5-13 years can participate.
- The registration fees defined by the British Council for the entire Reading Challenge is **INR 1500**/- per participant.

The fee includes:

- ✓ A Reading Challenge membership card for the programme
- ✓ Books to borrow from an exclusive selection of books on Animal Agents
- ✓ Training materials and facilitator's costs
- ✓ Refreshments and hospitality
- ✓ Welcome kit, Incentives and stationery
- ✓ Certificates and Medals from Reading Agency and British Council on successful completion

- They will get the welcome kit and have the access to a special collection of books issued by the British Council and they have to attend the scheduled workshops
- All participants will be provided with a certificate and a medal (to be eligible, they should have read a minimum of 6 titles from the collection)
- The books and participatory kits will be made available through the school post student confirmation and receipt of contact details (name, age, e-mail address and contact number) and registration fees. The school will coordinate for the same.
