This workshop is designed to help you identify and overcome such barriers/patterns. Carefully designed and structured theatre games and exercises, enhancing sensitivity in human interaction, will be used to develop your full potential for positive and fruitful communication. Here, we aim to initiate a continuing process of dialogue, reflection and action for creating a change in the special bond between you and your child – a bond that we hope will be guided by these famous words of Benjamin Franklin: "Tell me and I forget, teach me and I may remember, involve me and I learn."
