

Highlighted activities of the Month**Environmental studies**

Children wanted to explore and collect more information related to plants. To seek more information on different types of plants and their adaptation for different regions, children did research work as well learnt about the same during the field visit to "Parimal Garden." They learnt about the indoor plants and fertilizers. They also learnt about the effect of deforestation by researching on Aarey forest and this led to the discussion on how to take care of plants and side effect of cutting plants. The learnings from the project done was reflected when children talked about the formation of day and night and about the effect of different seasons on our lives. They also discussed about the different food, clothes and activities done in different seasons. They also talked about the roles and responsibilities of people in a family and how we are dependent on different people in our daily lives.

**Mathematics**

Children drew shapes like square, rectangle, cube and cuboid using the scale with the given measurements. Children showed their understanding of concepts related to number sense like: computation, ordering comparing through the use of manipulatives. Children had first hand experience on using measuring tape.

**English**

Children enjoyed reading the book "Wombat goes walk about". They were enthusiastic to know about Australian animals. Children comprehended the story well. They were able to un-jumble the given sentences from the text. Children made riddles on animals using describing and action words. Children enacted and presented various animals by their sounds in front of their peers. They learnt to make fact file on animals which included the drawing and description of animal, diet, habitat and interesting facts.
