Subject: Revision Week and Non-Graded Quiz (End of Semester 1)

Dear Parents,

We are coming closer to the completion of first semester for this academic year. We are extremely proud of our students who have quickly adapted to remote learning, and also thankful to our parent community for extensive support in this process.

At this important juncture, it is important for students to get an opportunity to revise and revisit their learnings from the semester. In a regular school, a semester-end exam provides such an opportunity. Due to remote learning, we have decided to not conduct first semester-end exams for Class 5 and Class 6 students this year.

However, to provide students an opportunity to recapitulate their learning, a revision week is planned. During the revision week, a **non-graded Quiz** for the core subjects will be conducted. The purpose of the quiz is to help students consolidate their full semester learnings and to showcase their understanding. It will include the content covered during Theme 1, Theme 2, Project 1 and Theme 3 (two weeks) i.e. till 9th October 2020.

The quiz will help teachers to provide specific qualitative feedback to students on their learning, and guide them further in their learning journey. There will be no marks or grades awarded for this quiz. During these weeks, the regular subject classes will also focus on revision rather than introducing any new concepts.

Parents should encourage students to review and revise what they have learnt in Semester 1 before the quiz, but do not place any pressure for performance.

The Quiz will be accessible only during the specified time and duration. The schedule is given as below:

Note:

- For English, EVS and ICT the online quiz will be conducted in two parts as mentioned above, and students need to attend and complete both the parts.
- For Section A, students will solve the answers in the google form and submit.
- For Section B, the questions will be in the Google form. The students will write the answers in their notebook, take a picture and upload the PDF in the Google classroom under the topic of Semester Assignment. The students will leave the classroom once the paper is uploaded in the google classroom.

- For Math the online quiz will be conducted in two parts as mentioned above, and students need to attend and complete both the parts.
- For both Section A and Section B, the questions will be in the Google form. The students will write the answers in their notebook, take a picture and upload the PDF in the Google classroom under the topic of Semester Assignment. The students will leave the classroom once the paper is uploaded in the google classroom.

- For the online quiz, students will login into their respective subject Google classroom via Google Meet Id. The Google form link for the Quiz can be accessed from the chat box during the live session.

- For Hindi and Gujarati offline quiz, the teachers will post the assignment exactly at the time it is scheduled and students are expected to write the answers in their respective subject notebook, take a picture and upload the pdf in the respective Google Classroom under the topic of Semester Assignment. The teachers will be available offline on Google classroom for doubts.


The students will be oriented by respective subject teachers on the process of conducting the quiz.
