#### Dear Parents,

This is to inform you regarding the exciting outbound adventurous and educational camp that we have planned for our senior school students this year.

In order to give our students a broader exposure and leadership experience, the camp has been planned outside Gujarat and will include **3 nights 4 days** stay at the site. The camp is planned at **Aravali Valley**, **Dhauj**, **Haryana (50 kms from New Delhi)**. The camp's total duration will be **5 nights and 6 days** including travel days.

A professional and reputed school adventure camps service provider - Holiday Moods Adventures- will conduct the camp. (It is a licensed company by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and approved as an adventure tour operator since 2000. It was the first company in India to be cleared with this accreditation. The company is also top rated by National Geographic Adventures as one of the best companies to work in India.)

This camp is **<u>compulsory</u>** for all the students to attend, as this will be a life-transforming experience for them.

(For Class 9 and Class 10 students, this camp is a requirement for their IAYP (International Award for Young People) program. As per IAYP program requirements, for earning a bronze and silver level award, an outbound adventure program of 4 days and 3 nights has to be completed.)

The camp serves to provide life skills, leadership skills, adventure skills, rural and community service experiences to students through various planned activities.

# DAY 3 - 18<sup>th</sup> November 2017 ANIMAL SHELTER / COMMUNITY SERVICE – SPONSOR A MEAL

- Post breakfast, we help in cooking a meal at the camp for the children of the local school in village Selakhari. (Poori Aloo with halwa). The group is divided and one batch cooks and one batch serves the meal.
- 11:00 pm Board tractors to the local school
  - Patriotic songs interaction with the children
  - Donate Books, Stationary & Sports goods
  - Serve a meal to the Children.

The students be taken to local villagers' houses, they would also get a firsthand experience of seeing hand pumps, tube wells, fodder cutters, cattle rearing, milking and trying or observing magnificent Indian rural hukkah.

• Village Clean Up – we visit the village Selakhari. The group helps in cleaning up a section of the village giving a clear message of sanitation to the villagers.

- A short walk to the local village. First cultural impression of the rural India. Interact with the villagers.
- Return back to the camp for lunch
- Post Lunch, we walk to the animal Orphanage

The experience would also cover a large animal shelter where they could get information on environment conservation and animal welfare. They would get a guided tour inside the animal shelter as well where they could pet animals such as dogs, cats, emus, sheep, horses, cows, birds etc. For those who feel strongly for the cause, they could also contribute to feeding the animals or volunteer at the shelter for a short span of time.

# ANIMAL SHELTER & ORGANIC FARM

The Animal Shelter started as recent as in 2013, takes care of 320 Dogs, 60 Large Animals including cows, bulls, buffaloes, horses, donkeys, mules 17 Emus, 35 Cats, 40 Rabbits, 50 Ducks and Geese and many birds. The struggle is to raise 6 Lakhs a month to take care of the animals. With the construction of the shelter completed in February 2013, the dogs have moved in, and are enjoying their new home. The shelter is located on a 2.5 acre plot alongside the organic farm. The endeavor is to synergies the existence of all beings with the environment to ensure a discrimination free harmony.
