We also would appreciate if parents could contribute some things as mentioned below towards the project.

**Natural Resources:-** Feathers, Pieces of sun mica/wood, Springs, Shells.

**Boxes/containers :-** Cardboard boxes-of all sizes (toothpaste covers,soap boxes ,gift boxes,big cartons ,baby food containers etc), Empty foil and cling wrap rolls, toilet paper rolls, Lids of bottles, Used Tin Cans, Egg cartons, Old baskets (cane/plastic), Empty bottles of all capacity(shampoo cream ,cold drinks), Spools (*Cylindrical device on which thread, magnetic tape can be wound*)(big and small).

**Other old material** :- Metal bangles, Cloth pieces of different textures, Old toy Tyres, Old push and pull toys , PVC pipe pieces, Old hangers, Old utensils, Old batteries, Old Newspaper, Old curtain rings, Plastic flowers, Old CDs, Old tent houses,Springs.

Parents are requested not to buy anything but recycle .We would also request you to please ensure that the materials are washed and cleaned for reuse.**The collection drive for the same would start from 24<sup>th</sup> October , Wednesday to 31st October, Wednesday**. Parents are therefore, requested to drop the Materials at the drop box provided near the entrance (during the respective child's pick and drop time).
