## Dear Parents,

The Academic Year 2020-21 has been an unprecedented year for all of us. As we look back, we are proud and grateful to see how our entire community (students, teachers, parents) has adapted well to this new model of schooling. With the promise of vaccines, we hope to see our children back in school campus soon!

We thank the parents who attended the session organized by the school on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and subsequent screenings of the same. We appreciate the constructive dialogue built in the session and the resolutions we were able to reach together. This year has impacted everyone not only *physically* but also *emotionally* and *financially*. As an institution, we have been mindful of our *responsibility* and strived to do our best despite our own challenges, in order to sustain the quality of education for our children.

Since inception, our goal has been to build a high quality school while maintaining affordability for parents. Our vision has been to mould Redbricks into one of the best schools of the country and the world, and at the same time be able to self-sustain itself to impact many future generations. Over the last 12 years, the school has made consistent progress on these goals, with the hard work of its staff and support of the parent community. We all understand that it is important for the school to continue receiving its planned revenues in order to remain financially sustainable.
