However, since this year has again started with remote learning, we would like to give students more time to adjust to a new grade and program and the larger situation, before summative/graded tests are conducted.

We will start this Semester with 'non-graded quizzes' like last year, and we will plan to shift to a graded-tests methodology (i.e. UEA) when we feel it is the right time for students. Apart from these non-graded quizzes, teachers will also constantly monitor student progress through evidence of their ongoing work and their participation in the classes.
