
- Students are expected to adhere to the above specified dates and times of the assessment schedule.
- For English, Maths, ICT and EVS, assessment will be conducted in two parts - Part 1 and Part 2.
 - For English, ICT and EVS, Part 1 will be answered in Google form itself and submitted during the live Google Meet session.
 - For Part 2 of these subjects and Maths (Part 1 and Part 2), the PDF of the paper will be shared with students in their respective subject Google Classroom during the UEA time in Google Meet. Students will answer in their notebooks and upload a scanned copy (PDF format) of the same in their respective subject Google Classroom before they leave the meeting.
- For Gujarati and Hindi, online assessment will be conducted in one part only. The teachers will post the PDF of the paper in the respective google classroom during the UEA time in Google Meet. Students are expected to write the answers in their subject notebook and upload a scanned copy (PDF format) of the same on the respective Google Classroom.
- Gujarati oral assessment will be conducted through the respective Google Classroom. Students will need to submit the same by 21st July.
- Students will be oriented by respective subject teachers on the process of conducting the test.
- Students will have regular sessions during the test as per the regular remote learning timetable.

The subject wise syllabus to be covered in the UEA test is given in Annexure 1 below.

We trust that our students will be sincere and practice honesty while attempting this test, because it is in their best interest. We suggest that one parent / guardian is available in the background while the child is taking the test, but please do not help the child in answering any part of the test.
