## Note:

- For English, EVS and Maths, the quiz will be conducted in two parts as mentioned above, and students need to attend and complete both the parts.
- For the online quiz, students will login into a Google Meet session using their respective subject Google Meet Id. The Google form link for the Quiz can be accessed from the chat box during the live session.

- For the offline quiz, the teachers will post the assignment in the respective subject Google classroom exactly at the time it is scheduled and students are expected to write the answers in their respective subject notebook and upload a scanned copy (PDF format) of the same on the respective Google Classroom.
- Students will be oriented by the respective subject teachers on the process of conducting the quiz.
- Students will have regular sessions during the quiz period as per the regular remote learning timetable.

Please note that this Quiz is not a test – it will not be assigned any marks or grades to students. Students will get qualitative feedback on their performance by teachers, to further support their learning. Parents should encourage students to review and revise what they have learnt in Theme 2 before the quiz, but do not place any pressure for performance.
