We are closely monitoring the COVID-19 situation and are planning for a staggered physical school reopening for various age groups.

It is important that we reopen cautiously and methodically for the safety and wellbeing of our students. We have already initiated this process by organizing some physical visits of our Class 6 to Class 8 students on campus.

We are aware that many parents are eager to send their children to physical school more regularly now. With the current festive season (Navratri and Diwali), we would like to wait for some time after Diwali before we start calling our Grade 6-8 students more regularly to the campus. It is important to see the after-effects of the festive season on the COVID-19 situation, before we resume more regular physical schooling.

Rest assured, we are also keen on having our students back on campus, and we continue to take well-deliberated yet timely decisions after reviewing the situation.


- Initially, the school will continue with a **blended learning model** where the students will learn from school 2-3 days/week and learn from home for the rest of the week.
- This form is **compulsory** to submit, irrespective of whether you are interested or not interested in sending your child to the physical school.
- Please note that this is **not a formal consent form**, and it is just to collect your perspective and aid us in further planning. A formal consent form will be sent closer to the reopening date.

Kindly submit the form latest by **20th October 2021, Thursday**.
