As this academic year draws to a close, we are in the process of planning for the upcoming Academic Year 2018-19. We are excited to continue the journey with our Class 10 students into the next academic year with the start of Class 11 - ISC programme scheduled to commence from 11th June 2018.

In reference to our earlier verbal conversations, we will be offering Commerce stream in the coming academic year. Attached here is the **factoid sheet** with more details of the ISC program. The school will continue to provide a rigorous academic programme, individualized attention and holistic exposure to our Class 11 students.

The subjects that will be offered in Class 11 and Class 12 ISC are as below:

- Compulsory Subject: English Language and Literature
- Elective 1: Accounts
- Elective 2: Maths/ Business Studies (students to choose any 1 subject out of the 2 subjects)
- Elective 3: Economics
- Elective 4: Commerce

The school has selected these subjects keeping in mind the undergraduate admission requirements for various mainstream courses, after pursuing Commerce in high school.

In order to help us plan effectively for the next session, please fill out the '**Confirmation form**' below for continuation in Class 11 as well as an initial indication of the Elective 2 subject selection in careful consultation with your child.

Please note that admission to Class 11 is provisional until the declaration of Class 10 results. This choice of Elective 2 subject you are making is tentative and you can change it after the declaration of the Class 10 results. We are only asking you for this to help us with our planning.

Students and Parents may approach the class teacher and the school counselor (Ms. Naina Suri) to discuss about a careful selection of the subject choice as per the student's aptitude and career plans.
