Subject: Consent for your ward's participation in the Remedial Program

Dear Parent,

In order to provide children with an opportunity to be successful in academics, the school is initiating an after school remediation program that will begin from 11th September, 2018.

This program is an opportunity for those students who require more focused inputs/practice to develop their Mathematics and English skills. The program shall not focus on homework/classwork completion; but on re-teaching basic concepts and practicing critical skills facilitated by subject teachers.

The program will be implemented for Class 7 to Class 11 students every Tuesday from 1:45 to 3:00, when they will need to stay back at school (Departure Bus Time - 3:10pm). A child may be required to undergo remediation either in English or Maths or both the subjects.

Your child has been nominated to participate in the remedial program for the following subject/s:

Maths English Both Maths and English



*Please note: If your child is attending remedial class only in one subject, then in the other subject slot, extra worksheets would be given for practice or the child can do any activity of his/her choice or take some rest.

Support required from parents –

- Parents are requested to send an extra box of snacks for their child.
- Children need to carry one extra 80-100 pages notebook for each of the two subjects- English and Maths- for the remedial program. The notebook design should be same as the book used for classwork for the respective subject.
- Parents are required to ensure that their children complete the homework which may also be given as a part of the remedial program.
- As the school is making an attempt to provide additional help to your child at his/her skill level and to avoid any confusions in learning patterns, we recommend that your child does not go for tuition classes.

The progress of your child will also be reviewed on a regular basis and in case there are any changes we would keep you updated.
