Subject: Formative Assessment for Theme 1

Dear Parents,

We are happy to see the enthusiastic participation of our students, and their intensive efforts during remote learning. In the journey of learning, a learner should receive continuous feedback on his/her learning for better future direction. Teachers and parents also need to gauge learner progress, in order to help and support them further.

As we have completed the first theme through remote learning, it is an important milestone to gauge student progress on the content and skills taught. In a face-to-face teaching context, unit-end assessment tests (UEA's) are conducted at the end of the theme for this purpose. However, in the context of remote learning, we want to give students more time to adapt to this mode before we conduct such tests.

Therefore, we have decided to largely focus on *formative assessment* at the end of Theme 1. This will be done by teachers as below:

- Evidences of student's ongoing work from the entire theme
- Participation of the student during online classes
- Conducting a Quiz to gauge student learning

Please note that this Quiz is not a test – it will not assign any marks or grades to students. Students will get qualitative feedback on their performance. It is an end-point formative assessment technique, to help students get feedback on their learning. Parents should encourage students to review and revise what they have learnt in Theme 1 before the quiz, but do not place any pressure for performance.

The Quiz will be conducted in the coming week and it will be accessible only during the specified time and duration. The schedule is given as below:
