Dear Parents,

Greetings! We hope you and your family are in good health.

Another exciting and eventful academic year is on the threshold, as children embark upon new adventures in the world of learning. On behalf of team Redbricks, we would like to welcome you to a new academic year, in which we hope to establish and maintain a healthy home-school connection with your family throughout the year.

As a prelude to the session, we would like to share with you essential information, to help our students get ready before the start of the school on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

#### **A) School Timing & Working days**

##### **Transition Week Timings (13<sup>th</sup> June 2022 - 18<sup>th</sup> June 2022)**

- **Monday - Friday:** 7:55 a.m. to 11:35 a.m
- **Saturday (18<sup>th</sup> June):** 9:10 to 10:45 a.m (Virtual Classes only)

*Please note that students should carry snacks for the short break and there will be no lunch break during the transition period due to shorter timings.*

##### **Regular School Timings (20<sup>th</sup> June onwards)**

- **Monday - Friday:** 7:55 a.m. to 1:35 p.m
- **Saturday:**
  - 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of the month: On-campus 7:55 a.m. to 1:35 p.m
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays of the month: Non-working days for students
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday & 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday (if any) of the month: Virtual School
    - *Please note that keeping in mind our experience of the last two years of remote learning, we have decided to keep only the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of the month working from campus for students. We intend to utilize the other working Saturdays in a more flexible manner through the use of technology for hosting office hours and some classes.*
    - For Class 9 and Class 10, virtual and optional office hours with teachers and few online classes will be conducted as per the timetable.
    - *Timings for the above will be shared in the timetable.*
  - *Please note that from time to time, school events and/or field trips might be planned on the non-working Saturdays.*
- *A detailed and specific weekly timetable for 20<sup>th</sup> June onwards will be shared some time over the next few days.*

## **B) International Award for Young People (IAYP)**

IAYP is an individual challenge where our students will be participating in a non-competitive program of voluntary activities which encourage personal discovery and growth, self-reliance, perseverance, responsibility to themselves, and service to their community. This award has 4 mandatory activity categories - Voluntary Service, Adventurous Journey, Skills, and Physical Recreation. In order to ensure holistic development of our students, they will be participating in this program at the Bronze level. Students will be briefed on this program and the registration fees in the first week of school reopening.

## **C) School Essentials**

The Student ID cards will be distributed in the week of school reopening for the entire school ( 20<sup>th</sup> June - 25<sup>th</sup> June ).

## **D) School Uniform:**

**The school uniform design remains the same as before:**

- **Summer Uniform**
  - Boys (Class 1 to 4): Red T-shirt with School logo and grey shorts.
  - Boys (Class 5 onwards): Red T-shirt with School logo and grey pants.
  - Girls (Class 1 onwards): Red T-shirt with School logo and grey skirts.
  
- **Winter Uniform**
  - Blue sweater with School logo.
  - For Girls - black cotton full-length leggings to be worn under the uniform, grey skirt (other colored pants will not be allowed for girls).
  
- **House Uniform (to be worn on 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday and for special events when intimated)**
  - House T-Shirts of respective house colors
    - Ashoka House- Blue
    - Vikramaditya House- Purple
    - Chandragupta Maurya- Orange
    - Maharana Pratap- Green
  
- **Sports Uniform**
  - Black color tracks with Red Trim (for boys and girls - change over in school).

**Uniform Specifications:** The skirt length for girls should be one inch above the knee and the length of the trouser for boys should not be beyond their ankle. The t-shirt should be of appropriate fitting and size (not too tight or too loose).

The shoes will be available at the Liberty exclusive store at Swastik Cross Road, Navrangpura or parents can purchase the shoes from any other store of their choice.


