Redbricks undertakes an initiative "Reading Program" for our students to inculcate reading habits among the children from an early age. As a part of this program, once in a *fortnight* the class teacher will issue an age-appropriate book to the child to carry home for reading. We would be increasing the frequency to *weekly* in the second semester for kindergarten and once in ten days for EYP. We request parents to help the child to read this book, ask a few questions to generate curiosity and discuss what the child has read.

Having access to information through the printed word is an absolute necessity to succeed in life. Through books we can enrich our minds, we can also relax and enjoy some precious leisure moments. We believe that parents should try to take time out to read with the child everyday while they are young. With your help, your children can begin a lifelong relationship with the printed word, so they grow into adults who read easily and frequently for various purposes.

Please make sure that the books issued from the school library are taken care of and returned by the date specified by the teacher on the Seesaw app while issuing. Only one book would be issued at a time. In case a book is damaged or lost, parents would need to replace the same book for the school.

It is always our endeavor to build a well stocked library of books with internal resources. Parents are welcome to donate old books in good condition towards the school library.
